Scope of Work/Project Narrative:

Work includes materials and labor necessary to treat 7121 diameter inches (384 ash trees) in our parks and along the streets throughout the City of Fort Wayne.

Bids were requested on behalf of the Board of Park Commissioners 2013 and 5 responses were received. Davey Resource Group was the lowest, most responsive bidder. Davey has agreed to extend this unit cost pricing of \$4.31 per diameter inch for the tenth consecutive year.

We request the Boards approval for a contract with Davey Resource Group at a total cost of \$30,691.51 funded through budget (355-P260-5369) to treat 384 ash trees.
