#### FINANCIAL OBJECTIVE AND JUSTIFICATION STATEMENT:

Headwaters Park, located just north of the central city business district, is home to many festivals, concerts, charitable and other special events. The large open-air pavilion is available for public rental and makes a wonderful setting for weddings, receptions, company picnics and family reunions. During the cold weather months, the pavilion houses the popular Headwaters Ice Skating Rink. In the late 1990s, the developing Headwaters Park project became one of the largest public-private partnerships existing in Northern Indiana. Together, both the public and private sectors raised nearly \$17 million to complete the downtown revitalization. Because of its broad appeal, support came from all areas of the community. Fort Wayne and Allen County governments contributed \$5.2 million for land acquisition, environmental remediation, and business relocation costs.

On April 1, 2023 the Fort Wayne Parks and Recreation Department (FWPRD) took over the operation of Headwaters Park from the Headwaters Park Alliance. During this transitional year we have learned about the different cost structures that were provided by the alliance and are looking to simplify the fee structure to make rental fees simple and efficient. One of these changes is keeping the cost to rent the pavilions similar across any type of event. The alliance had private event, wedding, walk/run and non-profits at all different cost ranges. For 2024 we will simplify these fees to one fee no matter the type of the event being held at the pavilions. One major fee change will be the grassy areas on both the West and East side of Headwaters Park. After our first event season we noticed the grassy areas were underpriced for the cost of maintenance on repairs on the grassy areas. This increase will help with the long-term maintenance of these areas.



## **ANTICIPATED REVENUE IMPACTS**

We anticipate these rental fee increases at Headwaters will bring an additional \$10,000 in revenue for the 2023-2024 season. This will be the first season FWPRD to operate the ice rink at Headwaters Park and would estimate additional gross revenues of \$10,000 for this part of the operation.

# **Headwaters Park Ice Rink Concessions**

Manager of Riverfront may adjust pricing after total cost with mark-ups between 50-200%. Concession items will be review and priced at the start of the Ice-Skating season no later than

November 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. They will remain the same throughout the season unless the item increases significantly in cost, in which time the Riverfront Manager will cost out items using the pricing guidelines. Items that do not sell after a minimum of 30 days on display will be reviewed by the Riverfront Manager. The Riverfront Manager may implement a price markdown to move stock before it expires.

## **Headwaters Park Ice Rink Group Rates/ Rentals**

Group rates will require a minimum of 25 people per group and will receive a .50 off admission for each group member per approval by the Riverfront Manager.
