

Some important changes to be aware of, as you plan your visit to the ice rink this season:

- 1) Masks **MUST** be worn at all times during your visit to the ice rink. If you choose to not abide by this rule, you will be asked to leave the ice rink. Refunds will **NOT BE GIVEN**.
- 2) Social distancing standards must be adhered to when not on the ice.
- 3) Hand sanitizer will be available in multiple locations throughout the facility. Ice rink staff members will be frequently sanitizing surfaces within the ice rink confines.
- 4) Gathering in the admissions space will **NOT** be allowed, in order for social distancing standards to be observed.
- 5) There is a maximum of 50 people allowed on the ice at any time, per the Department of Health. Please be patient as we monitor on-ice numbers.

This may mean you will be asked to wait when you arrive at the rink, before you begin skating.

6) Due to the change of logistics involved, we will not be able to accommodate field trips or other private parties this season.

IF YOU ARE EXHIBITING ANY QUESTIONABLE SYMPTOMS, PLEASE STAY HOME FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY.
These symptoms would include: fever, cough, runny nose, headaches.

We understand these changes are not what you are used to when you visit the ice rink. However, in order to open **FOR YOU** this season, these are the parameters that we must ask our visitors to follow.
