Scope of Work:

This project consists of the removal/replacement of the old and outdated gasoline pumps at the Lawton Park maintenance yard. This consists of removing old pumps, the removal of the existing concrete slab and digging down to the underground tanks to remove old piping. Install new piping and sumps on the existing tanks. Backfill and pour new concrete pad, and install two new twin pumps on island in the center of the gasoline fill area.

One quote was received on behalf of the Board of Park Commissioners on October 25 2022. The bid that was received for this project was from Gasoline Equipment. Gasoline Equipment is the sole contractor for the city and the parks department for gasoline repairs and replacements.
