Great Tree Canopy Comeback 2022

The Great Tree Canopy Comeback (GTCC) **began in 2001** with the mission & focus to restore a canopy that was found to be severely lacking in the Parks System. Since the first annual event, the GTCC has been responsible for planting over 2,750 trees in multiple parks and trails throughout the county. This planting success, with the addition of other tree care needs, caused the GTCC to **evolve in 2018**. There was a reduction in the number of trees that were planted with an additional element to the event, the removal of invasive shrubs and trees from the parks' natural wooded areas. **It's now 2022** and we see the need to modify the event once more and add a tree maintenance element to the event. Because of the past success of the tree planting programs, a need has been growing to have volunteers help spread mulch around these young trees that have been planted within the past 5 years. This year you can choose to volunteer as a Planter/Tree Captain, Courier/Cutter, or a Mulcher at various parks & trails around the area.

1. Gift a Tree: Consider funding a tree, it is a lasting legacy to our community.
2. Volunteer: Please pick one of our sites listed below and pick how you would like to volunteer.

You will see (Plant), (Mulch), or (Invasive) after each location below; (Plant)- Planters & Tree Captains will plant trees, (Mulch)- Mulch tree rings around young trees, (Invasive)- Couriers & Cutters will remove invasive species.
