

Youth Scholarships

The Fort Wayne Parks and Recreation Department offers program scholarships for qualified children as funds are available.

Youth (18 years and younger) may apply for ONE Youth Scholarship up to \$75 to put toward ONE class/camp/program (excluding Zoo classes/program) per calendar year.

To qualify for one of the limited number of scholarships, you must provide a letter from your child's school stating he/she qualifies for free lunches and free textbooks.

If such a letter is not available, alternative official documentation may include:

1. A copy of the applicant family's most recent U.S. Internal Revenue Service Tax Return form (Social Security # blacked out)
2. An official letter from your state indicating qualification for Food Stamps.

To Register In Person

Fill out the program registration form and bring it with the letter from your school stating that you qualify for the free lunch and free textbooks to 705 E. State Blvd. Please bring a method of payment (credit card, check, cash) for any additional fees over \$75.

Register By FAX

FAX your school letter stating you qualify for the free lunch and free textbooks along with your program registration form to (260) 427-6020. Include your credit card number on the registration form to cover any fees above \$75. If your scholarship request is denied, the entire amount will be processed on your credit card.
