Face masks are optional during camp sessions. Campers are welcome to wear masks and for those with health concerns, please consult with your family doctor before attending camp.

- Stay home when we are sick

We ask that you help us protect the health of campers this summer. *Please take your camper(s)' temperature and check for these symptoms: fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, and loss of taste or smell.* Anyone who is sick or was sick with COVID-19 or recently in contact with someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days— including staff, campers, and families— should not come to camp. Call your doctor or the Allen County Department of Health if you think you or a family member is sick with COVID-19.
