ENTRY INFORMATION

1. Enter each event on the above form on or before the entry deadline for that event. **DO NOT ENTER AN EVENT AFTER THE ENTRY DEADLINE ENTRIES FOR EACH EVENT ARE LIMITED AND FILLED ON A FIRST PAID BASIS. ON-SITE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED WITH \$3 LATE FEE ADDED TO ORIGINAL FEE.**
2. Calculate the amount due for the event(s) that you are entering. The entry fees on the above form are per event. **THE ENTRY FEE INCLUDES THE GREEN FEES.**
3. Make checks payable to the Board of Park Commissioners.
4. Mail or take your check with your completed entry(s) to Parks and Recreation Junior Golf, 705 E. State Blvd., Fort Wayne, IN 46805. **NOTE: Mailed entries must reach the Parks and Recreation Office on or before the entry deadline for your first event.** The Parks and Recreation Department does have a 24-hour drop box for your convenience.
5. No refunds will be given after the entry deadline date. **ENTER ONLY EVENTS IN WHICH YOU INTEND TO PLAY. All other refunds are subject to a \$5 or 10% processing fee, whichever is greater.**
6. If you need to withdraw from an event you have entered call Parks and Recreation main office and leave your name, age, phone number and event you are withdrawing from.
7. **Tee Times will be posted on the website no more than 2 days before the event. If you do not have internet access please call 427-6000 for tee times.**
8. **In the case of inclement weather please call the golf clubhouse at the course you are scheduled to play. Decisions on play will be made no earlier than 30 minutes prior to the first scheduled tee time of the day.**
9. The Fort Wayne Junior Golf Tour is a schedule of competitive tournaments not a "Learn-to-Play" or "Lessons" program. To help maintain a reasonable pace of play, maximum score limits may be established for each age division. Players who cannot maintain a reasonable pace of play or exceed maximum score limits will be asked to work on and improve their game before returning to another event. Tentative maximum score limits: 18 holes / boys 16-17 (105); boys 14-15 (112); girls 14-17 (120); 9 holes / boys 12-13 (60); girls 12-13 (65). Medal Play events will have a 10 stroke limit per hole (circle 10). After 10 strokes, pick-up and advance to the next tee.
10. Most events are Boys and Girls 12-13 (9 holes) and Boys and Girls 14-17 (18 holes).
11. Giveaways and refreshments will be provided at some events.

WELCOME TO THE JUNIOR GOLF TOUR!

The schedule this year consists of 8 events played at different Fort Wayne area golf courses. Tournaments will be played throughout the summer. Please note that registration is limited and the more popular events are expected to fill.

Tee Times will be posted on the website no more than 2 days before each event. If you do not have internet access please call 427-6000 for your tee time. Tee times for most events are scheduled between 7:00 a.m. and Noon and grouped by age division. **If you need to withdraw from an event call the Parks and Recreation main office at 427-6000 and leave your name, age, the event number, and your phone number.** There will be no refund or credit if you withdraw after the entry deadline date. **All other refunds are subject to a \$5 or 10% processing fee, whichever is greater.**

The Grand Prix is a series of eight events for boys and girls. The top three players in the girl's division and the top five players in the boy's division who accumulate the most grand prix points will win special awards at the end of the program.

Point System

1 st – 20	6 th – 10
2 nd – 18	7 th – 8
3 rd – 16	8 th – 6
4 th – 14	9 th – 4
5 th – 12	10 th – 2

*Two day totals determine points on Foster Event.

*Double points are awarded / Foster Tour Championship.

*The top 5 point earners in the 14-17 boys' age groups through the Foster Park Tour Championship will receive an automatic entry into the Fort Wayne Golf Association City Championship. They will not have to qualify and will pay a reduced entry fee.

Event #7 – July 1st & 2nd / Tour Championship at Foster Golf Course: The tour championship event will feature double grand prix points, longest putt, longest drive and closest to the pin contests.

Event #8 – July 11th / Shoaff Scramble will be a shotgun start. Players will be assigned to a morning or an afternoon shotgun start. Everyone plays eighteen holes.

Players are encouraged to wear proper golf attire. Golf shirts with collars and slacks or mid-thigh shorts are preferred. Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times. Soft spikes are now required on all courses.
