

# **Junior Golf Tour 2025**

It's not a pro tour, but it's just as much fun! The Junior Golf Tour allows youth ages 12-17 to test their skills against other young golfers on a variety of area courses. The schedule this year consists of 8 events played at different Fort Wayne area golf courses. Players may sign up for as many or few tournaments as they wish. Tournament formats and fees vary depending on age and location. Please note that registration is limited and the more popular events are expected to fill.

## **Tournament Play**

The Fort Wayne Junior Golf Tour is a schedule of competitive tournaments, not a "Learn-to-Play" or "Lessons" program. To help maintain a reasonable pace of play, maximum score limits may be established for each age division. Players who cannot maintain a reasonable pace of play or exceed maximum score limits will be asked to work on and improve their game before returning to another event. Tentative maximum score limits:

#### 18 holes

boys 16-17 (105) boys 14-15 (112) girls 14-17 (120)

#### 9 holes

boys 12-13 (60) airls 12-13 (65)

Medal Play events will have a 10 stroke limit per hole (circle 10). After 10 strokes, pick-up and advance to the next tee.

#### **Tee Times**

Individual tee times for each event will be posted on the website fortwayneparks.org no more than 2 days before each event. If you do not have internet access please call 427-0000 for your tee time. Tee times for most events are scheduled between 7:00 a.m. and noon and grouped by age division.

#### **Dress Code**

Players are encouraged to wear proper golf attire. Golf shirts with collars and slacks or midthigh shorts are preferred. Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times. Soft spikes are now required on all courses.

## **Grand Prix Point System**

The Junior Golf Tour uses the Grand Prix point system below. Players accumulate points throughout the Tour ending with the Foster Park Tour Championship (no points earned in the Shoaff Scramble). The top three girls and top five boys will receive awards at the end of the Tour.

The top five boys in the 14-17 age category automatically qualify for the Fort Wayne Men's Golf Association City Championship Tournament and may enter the tournament at a reduced fee.

The Shoaff Florida Scramble on July 11 will be an 18-hole event with a shotgun start. Players will be assigned to a morning or an afternoon start time. No points are awarded at this event. There will be awards and a picnic.

#### **How to Enter**

- 1. Use the registration form on back or sign up online at fortwayneparks.org. You may register for all desired events at one time or register for individual events prior to the entry deadline for each. Please do not submit a registration form after the entry deadline for an event. If you miss a deadline, you may sign up on-site if space is available. A \$3 late fee will be charged.

- 2. Calculate the amount due for the event(s) that you are entering. The entry fees on the registration form are per event. Green fees are included in the entry fee for each event.
- 3. Make checks payable to the Board of Park Commissioners.
- Mail or drop your completed entry form with payment to: Parks and Recreation Junior Golf 705 E. State Blvd. Fort Wayne, IN 46805.

NOTE: Mailed entries must reach the Parks and Recreation Department on or before the entry deadline for your first event. The Parks and Recreation Department does have a 24-hour drop box for your convenience.

5. No refunds will be given after the entry deadline date. Enter only events in which you intend to play. All other refunds are subject to a \$5 or 10% processing fee, whichever is greater.

#### **Cancellations**

If you need to withdraw from an event you have entered call the Parks and Recreation Department at 427-6000 and leave your name, age, phone number and event you are withdrawing from.

In the case of inclement weather please call the golf clubhouse at the course you are scheduled to play. Decisions on play will be made no earlier than 30 minutes prior to the first scheduled tee time of the day.
