# Pee Wee Golf Tour 2025

It's not a pro tour, but it's just as much fun! The Pee Wee Golf Tour allows youth ages 3-11 to test their skills against other young golfers on a variety of area courses. The schedule this year consists of 5 events played at different Fort Wayne area golf courses. Players may sign up for as many or few tournaments as they wish. Tournament formats and fees vary depending on age and location. Please note that registration is limited and the more popular events are expected to fill.

## Tournament Play

The Pee Wee Golf Tour is a schedule of competitive tournaments, not a "Learn-to-Play" or "Lessons" program. Each participant should have golfing experience in a lessons program or playing with adults prior to entering an event. Each participant must have his/her own equipment including a bag, balls, tees and a minimum of three clubs. All tournaments are "caddy" events. Parents are encouraged to attend, walk with their child, carry their bag, help them in the decision making process and help with scorekeeping. No other assistance is allowed.

### Ages 3-5

Boys and girls ages 3-5 will play three holes, each approximately 100 yards in length.

### Ages 6-7 and 8-9

Boys and girls ages 6-9 will play six holes, each approximately 100 yards in length.

### Ages 10-11

Boys and girls ages 10-11 will play nine holes, each between 100-200 yards in length.

All events are medal play.

## Tee Times

Individual tee times for each event will be posted on the website [fortwayneparks.org](http://fortwayneparks.org) no more than 2 days before each event. If you do not have internet access please call 427-0000 for your tee time. **Golfers should report to the starter 15 minutes prior to their tee time.**

## Rules of Play . . .

Parents, if necessary, please help your child with the following:

Stand away from the ball during a practice swing.

Limit two practice swings per shot.

Balls must be played as they lie.

Do not hit your shot until the scorekeeper tell you to.


The fairway stroke limit is 10 strokes. On the 11th stroke, pick up the ball and place it on the nearest edge of the green.

No limit on putting. Continue putting until you "hole out."

Remain quiet and out of the view of other players as they hit their shot.

Repair ball marks, replace divots and rake bunkers.

Place your bag on the side of the green where the next tee is located.



## How to Enter

1. Use the registration form on back or sign up online at [fortwayneparks.org](http://fortwayneparks.org). You may register for all desired events at one time or register for individual events prior to the entry deadline for each. **Please do not submit a registration form after the entry deadline for an event. If you miss a deadline, you may sign up on-site if space is available. A \$2 late fee will be charged.**
2. Calculate the amount due for the event(s) that you are entering. The entry fees on the registration form are per event. **Green fees are included in the entry fee for each event.**
3. Make checks payable to the Board of Park Commissioners.
4. Mail or drop your completed entry form with payment to:

NOTE: Mailed entries must reach the Parks and Recreation Office on or before the entry deadline for your first event. The Parks and Recreation Department does have a 24-hour drop box for your convenience.
5. No refunds will be given after the entry deadline date. **Enter only events in which you intend to play.** All other refunds are subject to a \$5 or 10% processing fee, whichever is greater.



## Cancellations

If you need to withdraw from an event you have entered call Parks and Recreation at 427-6000 and leave your name, age, phone number and event you are withdrawing from.

In the case of inclement weather please call the golf clubhouse at the course you are scheduled to play. Decisions on play will be made no earlier than 30 minutes prior to the first scheduled tee time of the day.
