#### WHAT IS DRAGON BOAT RACING?

Dragon boat racing is a traditional water sport that originated in China over 2,000 years ago. It involves teams of paddlers propelling a long, narrow boat decorated like a dragon, complete with a dragon's head at the front and a tail at the rear. The boats are typically 40 to 50 feet in length and can accommodate up to 20 paddlers sitting side by side. A drummer is positioned at the front of the boat, setting the pace for the paddlers with rhythmic drumbeats, while a steersperson guides the boat from the rear. By entering a team for this event, your organization will gain exposure while creating a unique and lively team building experience. The sport promotes teamwork, physical fitness, and a sense of community, making it a thrilling and inclusive activity for participants of all ages and skill levels.

# FORM A TEAM AND JOIN THE FUN!

The Fort Wayne Parks and Recreation Department and Riverfront Fort Wayne invite your company, organization or group of friends to participate in the 2024 Fort Wayne Dragon Boat Races at Promenade Park. The fun begins on Friday, August 2nd at 6:00 p.m. with the Opening Ceremony performed by the Chinese Friends and Family Association, live music, food trucks and lighting of floating firepits on the St. Marys River. Teams are encouraged to come early (4:00 p.m.) to set up their team tent in the Athletes' Village on the Auer Lawn. The competition begins Saturday morning August 3rd at 9:00 a.m. with the ceremonial "awakening of the dragon" by dotting its eyes. Racing continues throughout the morning and early afternoon. On-shore games and contests keep the friendly competition going until a champion is crowned.

### **2024 Goals**

The 2024 Dragon Boat Races are poised to embrace a comprehensive set of goals that extend beyond the traditional realm of competitive racing. Primarily, the event aims to prioritize,

- Team building by implementing specialized workshops, training sessions, and collaborative activities that foster a strong sense of camaraderie among participants.
- The race seeks to serve as a cultural celebration, emphasizing Chinese traditions through cultural performances, educational initiatives, and immersive experiences that impart a deeper understanding of the sport's rich heritage.
- Quality of life enhancement is a pivotal objective, encouraging an active and healthy lifestyle through wellness programs, and fitness activities and river recreation.

#### **REGISTER YOUR DRAGON BOAT NOW!**

- Single Team Registration Fee: \$1,250 before 5/1
- \$1,500 after 5/1
- \$1,000 non-profit/school
- Team registration ends on July 12, 2024. Early registration ends May 1. Full payment must be made at the time of registration. Team rosters must be submitted on race day.
- Team Captains will receive a Captain's Manual upon registration with complete details.
- Your team must consist of 20 PADDLERS, one of whom is designated as the CAPTAIN and one as a DRUMMER (drummers cannot weigh more than 160 lbs). Team members must be at least high school age.
- Each team that registers will race their boat a minimum of two times on event day.
- Your team's registration includes one practice. Practice time will be scheduled on Tuesday through Friday the week of the event. (A schedule will be available at riverfrontfw.org/dragonboatraces)
- All of the necessary equipment will be supplied for your team during practices and on event day including boat, life vests, paddles and steerman/coach.
- Opening Ceremonies start at 6 p.m. on August 2nd with live music, food trucks, set-up of Athletes Village and floating firepits. Teams are encouraged to attend, however, it is not mandatory.
- Races start at 9 a.m. on August 3rd.
