SALOMON FARM PARK PHOTOGRAPHER RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Park Hours are from 6:00 a.m. - 11 p.m. every day.
2. **Pass fee of \$50.00 is nonrefundable. Fort Wayne Parks and Recreation and its staff hold the right to revoke/terminate a pass with no refund if a photographer is found in violation of any of these rules.**
3. Pass holders must wear their valid issued pass visibly on their persons or camera strap.
4. Photographers must notify Supervisor of Salomon Farm Park at 260.427.6790 or email salomonfarm@cityoffortwayne.org at least one week prior to a scheduled session with a client at Salomon Farm Park. Sessions may not occur during paid special events such as Concert on the Farm or Christmas on the Farm.
5. **Please do not feed the farm animals;** they have specific diets to keep them healthy. Please keep in mind some animals may bite/peck, so please use good judgement around the animals.
6. Please do not hang, tape, or affix props to buildings, pasture fences, or other park property or draw on walls, buildings and fences, **even with chalk.**
7. The Old Barn, Homestead, and the Learning Center and their surrounding grounds are rental spaces. **Photographers may not use or walk through areas occupied by a rental.** Please respect the rental patrons, their rental space, and the surrounding grounds (i.e. parking lots, sidewalks, bathroom building, surrounding barns, etc.).
8. All rental spaces are completely off limits to any photography session not directly connected to the private event rental. Any and all decorations that accompany private events are not to be used as backdrops or props for your pictures.
9. The Old Barn rental season runs from May 1st through October 31st with private events scheduled on all Fri., Sat., and Sundays during that time period; there are also some rentals on weekdays. The Learning Center is a rental facility all year long, except June and July.
10. Please park all vehicles in the Learning Center parking lot (first parking lot on property); **vehicles are not permitted on the grass, private drive, or agricultural lanes (dirt roads). Please notify clients of this.**
11. Please do not cut or take any flowers, crops, any plants, or animals (no collecting!). Take only photos, leave only footprints! Unless during flower u-pick hours.
12. **Pets must remain on a leash at all times and be kept away from barnyard area and any livestock/ farm animals.**
13. All photography sessions must comply with city ordinances.
14. Photographers are fully responsible for personal props. Props must be carried, **not driven**, to photo locations.
15. Please watch out for poison ivy in and around wooded and rocky areas, on trees, and in fields.
16. Any damage done to the property should be reported to the Supervisor of Salomon Farm Park.
17. Please do not climb on/ pose on farm machinery, gates, or fences.
18. Fishing permitted in pond with state fishing license.
