FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

How long do the tours last?

Private tours on the Sweet Breeze are typically 90 minutes long. An additional hour may be added for an extra cost.

How many people can ride?

Sweet Breeze can accommodate up to 38 riders. Different seating configurations can be arranged for smaller groups.

How much does it cost?

Sweet Breeze rentals start at \$1000. Additional fees may apply depending on scheduling and extra services.

Can we have food and drinks on the boat?

Yes, you may choose from one of our catering options for on-board dining.



If we don't plan to have catering, is there somewhere to eat nearby?

Where can we park for our tour?
